IATO Board Meeting June 2, 2024 – 9:30 am Iowa City West H.S., 2901 Melrose Ave, Iowa City, IA

Meeting called to order: Mark Tigges, IATO President called the meeting to order at 9:40 am.

Membership Report-Bill Neal, IATO Secretary reported that the IATO has added five new members since the clinic.

Treasurer's Report-Bill Neal, IATO Treasurer reported the IATO has \$10,295.46 in checking account. One outstanding bill to pay in September is for 200 boxes of .32 blanks. (\$8,800) MM- Jeff Cook SM-Fran Long

Old Business-

1-Track & Field Advisory Committee report was given by Jim Nichols. Next meeting will be June 5th. Issues discussed by IATO to take to Track & Field advisory committee were: 8 lb. shot puts at meets (illegal), intentional hurdle slamming with lead foot (illegal), move to metric system for field events, use of cones on curves at SQM, filming finish line at SQM, distance races in heat of day at state meet and runners feet outside exchange zone.

- 2-Cross Country Advisory Committee report was given by Fran Long. Coaches discussed team rankings, wanting more awards, course markings, course needs to be wider in places at state meet and opening course the day before the state meet. These were topics of discussion as no action was taken at the meeting. Ft. Dodge will host the 2025 State Cross Country meet.
- 3-Ammo Report was given by Bill Neal. As everyone should know at this time Winchester .32 and .22 blanks are no longer being made by Winchester. The IATO will have the following ammo available at the clinic this December.
- *.32 S & W blanks from Boland company in Florida. \$46 per box/50 shells per box. Starters will be able to purchase 8 boxes at the clinic. Boland .32 blanks work only in the Alpha .32 starting pistol. Boland .32 blanks will not work in Gun-X, NEF, S & W or H & R starting pistols. Don't order unless you have an Alpha .32 starting pistol.
- *.22 CCI blanks. \$18 per box/100 shells per box. Starters will be able to purchase 4 boxes at the clinic. These blanks are a short crimp and will work in all .22 starting pistols.
- *.22 Winchester blanks. \$12 per box/50 shells per box. Starters will be able to buy 8 boxes at the clinic. This is the last year that these will be available for sale from the IATO. We have several boxes left over from last season. Selling at a reduced price to sell out. Please be aware that each box may have some soft shells when fired. Will work in all .22 starting pistols. Last year for these !!!
- *9 mm Maxx Tech blanks. \$18 per box/50 shells per box. Starters will be able to buy 10 boxes at the clinic. The 9 mm blanks work in Zoraki R1 (2.5" barrel) and the Zoraki R2 (2" barrel). These 9 mm pistols cost around \$100. You can find the Zoraki starting pistol on the internet.

Bill Neal will be sending out attachments to IATO members which will go into further detail on ammo and availability.

4-Discussion of legal implements and legal long jump pits. Consensus of the IATO Board was that more schools weighed in implements and had more sand in long jump pits. Still finding illegal 8 lb. shot puts at meets and long jump pits 6" below the take off board. Need to make this a major emphasis for next year again.
